A GUIDE TO USING THE CHIPSTER FLASH DRIVE

What is the Chipster Flash Drive?

- A Chipster is a flash drive or chip that functions as a portable, digital library.
- It mimics the web but does not require internet access, allowing individuals around the world to study the educational material.

How to use the Chipster Flash Drive

- Remove the cap of the USB. Securely insert the flash drive into a USB port.
- When the Chipster Flash Drive is inserted, a file will pop up onto the screen. Click on the “Start Chipster” file.
- The Chipster is now opened, and all available resources are ready to use. All the tabs can be accessed without the internet.
- To close out of the Chipster, simply click the “X” in the top right and click “close tabs.”

Using the Library

- Utilize the built-in search engine to find specific topics or browse categories.
- The library supports various formats that allows users to read articles, view images, and access multimedia content.
- Users can duplicate content from the flash drive by dragging and dropping files from the Chipster flash drive to their computer or other devices.
